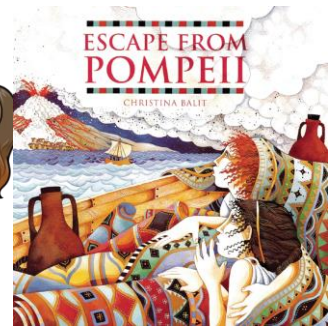
This is by FAR my favourite part of the week. Celebrating and showing off amazing learning and attitudes! Who knows, it could be you next!
