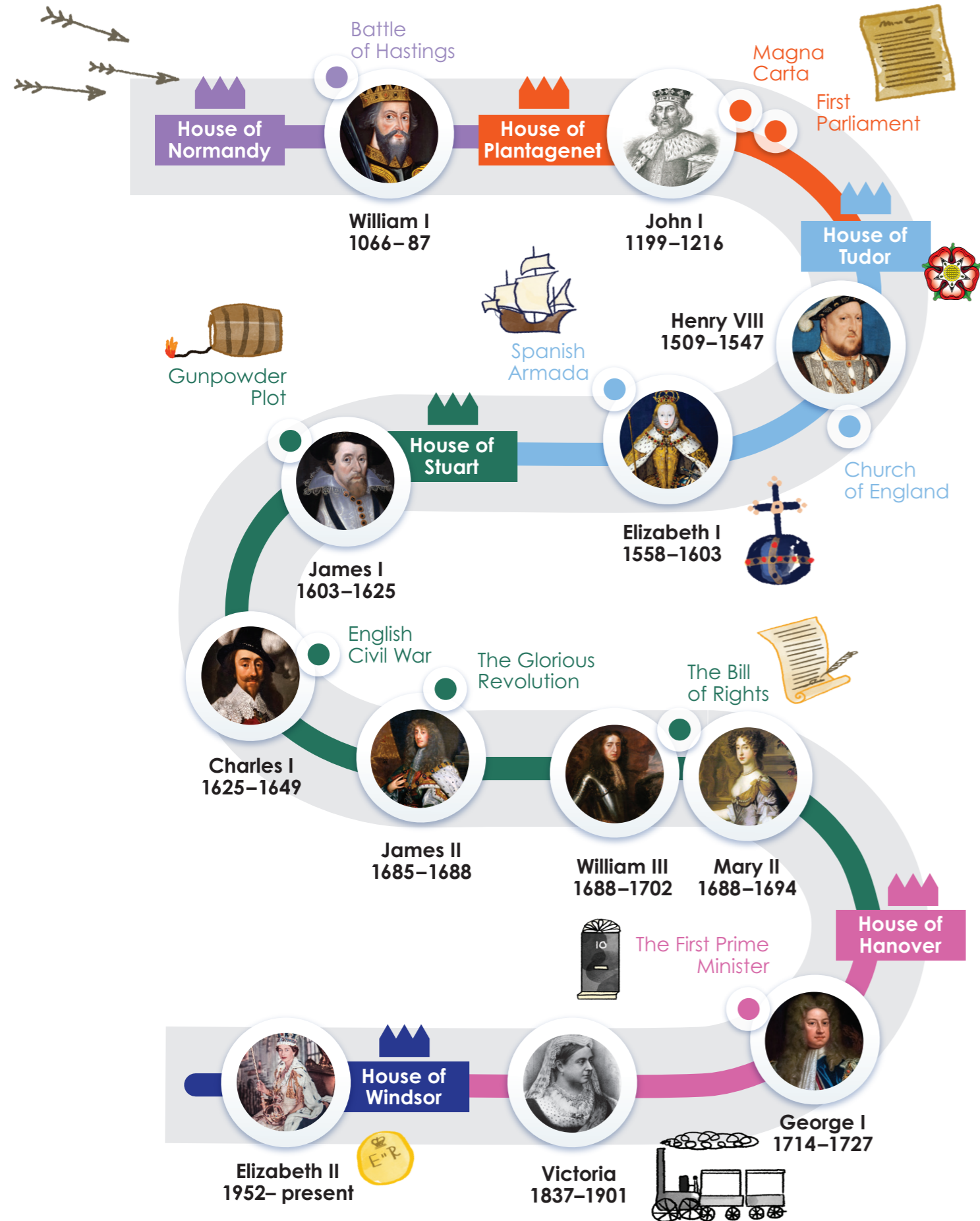


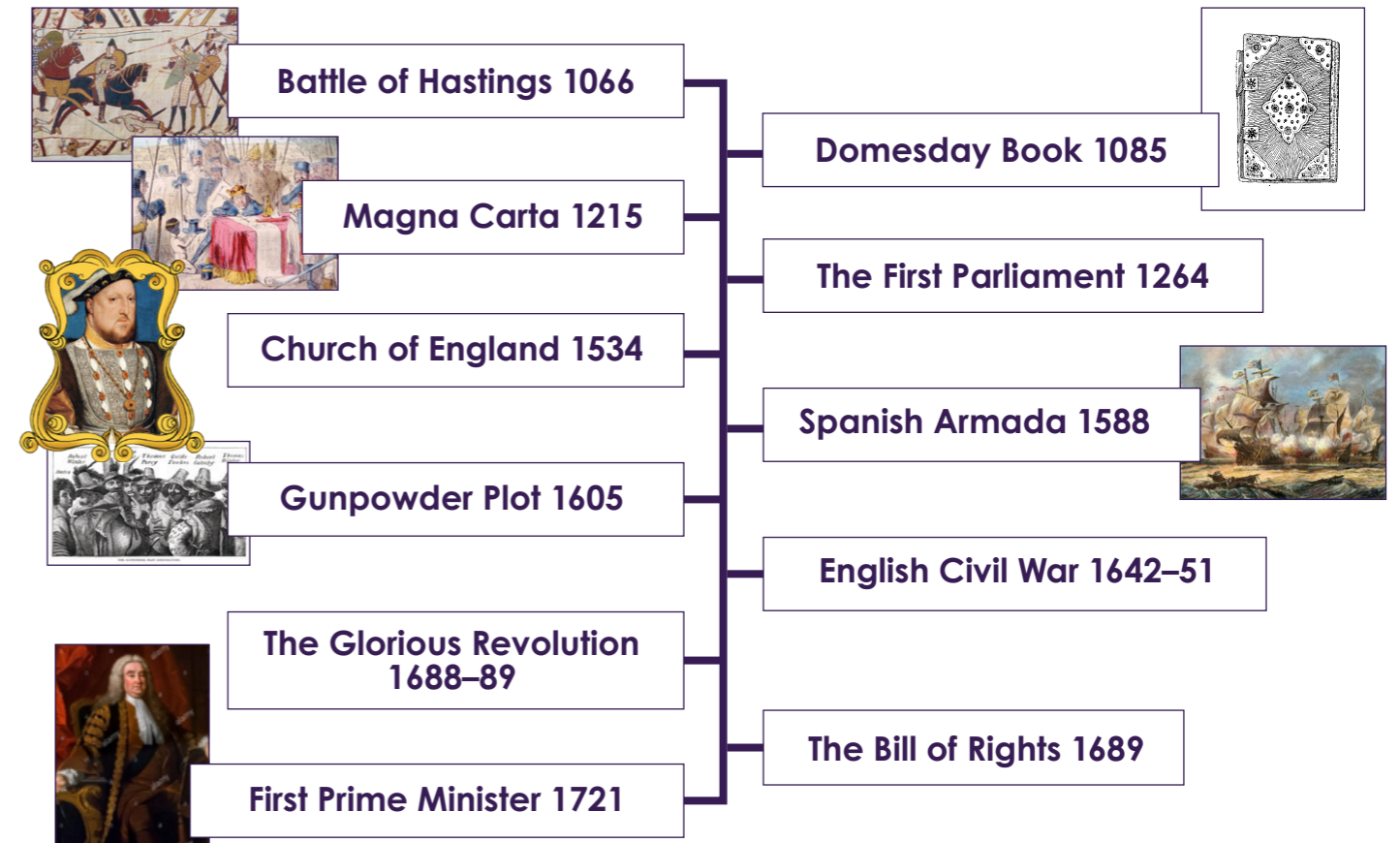


Kings and Queens since 1066 timeline
