Which countries are in Europe and what are they like?

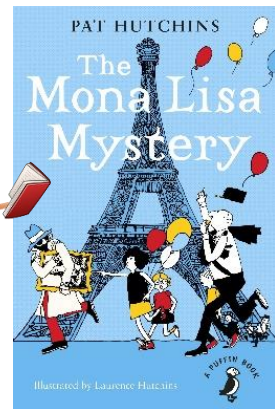
We are beginning a brand-new topic all about Europe, finding out which countries are in Europe, what their culture is like and comparing it to the UK.
